Payment and Policies

WE ACCEPT CASH, ZELLE, CHECKS SENT FROM YOUR BANK, PAY PAL, AND PERSONAL CHECKS
MADE OUT TO BALLET&BEYOND

Payment is due the 1st of every month. Some months have 3 weeks, some have 4 weeks and some have 5 weeks. The payment schedule is pro-rated thus regardless of the number of weeks the payment is the same each month. **After the 5th of the month there is a late fee of \$45.** It is preferred that you pay by semester to avoid late fees. Late fees are due immediately after the 5th of the month.

(These are small classes and your children are getting individual attention in each class!)

There is a parent observation week and performance for upper level classes in December, and a performance in the beginning of June for all.

ALL PAYMENTS ARE NON-REFUNDABLE!! Registration fee per family is \$80.00 per year

Adult group classes monthly fees are: 1 class a week \$95/2 classes a week \$180 Professionals \$20

Single or Open Classes \$30 per class/hour when you pay by the class.

At time of registration you must submit \$300 deposit towards the end of year show fee. October 1st second half of show fee \$300 is due. You must decide by October 1st if your child will participate in the end of year show. There are no refunds for any portion of the show after October 1st!! This fee includes 1 costume rental, some theatre costs, props, show costs, choreography fees, rehearsals, etc. There will be extra fees for additional costume cleaning and rentals, privates for solo's if chosen for a solo, and tickets for the show, etc.

NOTE: Dancers performing in the winter show (BALLET 4.5.6 Adult Ballet) will have a one time fee of \$295 to turn in at time of registration for Winter Show theatre fees. Extra fees will include costume rental fees and tickets for shows. No Refunds

DRESS CODE/CLASS REQUIREMENTS

Custom leotards will be purchased. These are required student uniform leotards. **The cost is \$65 per uniform leotard.** Dancers must purchase separately, pink tights and pink ballet shoes. Hair pulled back in a neat bun. No skirts, jewelry, or nails longer than finger tips.

BALLET I: PINK LEOTARD

BALLET II: LIGHT BLUE LEOTARD

BALLET III: WHITE LEOTARD

BALLET IV: BURGONDY LEOTARD

BALLET V: HUNTER GREEN LEOTARD

Ballet VI/Pre-Pro: BLACK LEOTARD (may wear optional leotard \$65)

There is a certain amount of commitment required from the parents and students for this to be a successful year like last year! September through January we work hard on ballet technique, January through June we continue working on technique, but we add choreography and rehearsals for the performance that takes place in the beginning of June. In order for the show to be as successful as it was last year it is very important that the students attend all the classes, especially from January on.

Missed classes may be made up only the same month and only if missed due to illness.

Students in any particular level may take any class below their level unless invited to take classes above level. If a student arrives more than 10 minutes late to class the student will sit and take notes. Unless there was an emergency. If a parent needs to speak with the teacher, they should do so in the morning but not during class time.

Students in Ballet 4 and above may purchase the unlimited class fee. The minimum required classes per level is as follows (unless your child is taking private lessons) but we strongly recommend taking as many classes, as this improves technique and level of dancing. If a student can't take the required minimum for their level class they may still take classes at \$25 per class but may not participate in the recital unless taking privates.

MINIMUM BALLET CLASS REQUIREMENT TO PARTICIPATE IN DESIGNATED LEVEL:

Ballet 1: 1 ballet class per week

Ballet 2: 2 ballet classes per week

Ballet 3: 4-5 ballet classes per week

Ballet 4: 8-11 classes per week (if on pointe must take minimum 6 classes)

Ballet 5: 8-12 classes per week (Unlimited Classes Recommended 14 classes)

Ballet 6: 9-12 classes per week (Unlimited Classes Recommended 14 classes)

The Ballet 6 class is for the serious dancer. Only those very serious committed dancers will be placed in this level.

***If a student can't come to the required number of classes to be in a particular level the tuition still remains the same for the required level.**
